HAMBLETON AND RICHMONDSHIRE COMMUNITY CAR SCHEME

The Hambleton and Richmondshire Community Car Scheme is a service set up to help people who are unable to access public transport due to disability, age or where they live.



How can we help you?

We will endeavour to take you to any destination. However our service depends on volunteers, so we appreciate as much notice as possible. We make no promises but will do our best to meet your needs.

What does it cost?

There is a mileage charge - currently 45p per mile - to cover the cost of the driver's expense and is subject to a minimum charge. This is calculated from the driver's home to the destination and back. We are a non-profit making organisation, with this charge paid direct to the volunteer.

Our core opening

10am - 12 noon

Hours may vary from

Additional Information

All our drivers have to supply references and undergo a Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) check. We ensure they have a current driving licence, MOT certificate and insurance for the vehicle they drive. We also provide public liability insurance for the driver whilst carrying out transport in association with the car scheme.

We provide transport for residents of Hambleton and Richmondshire.

All our drivers carry an id card - we will notify you of the driver's name.
