We are pleased that it makes people happy but we would also like to be able to encourage our clients in the Day Centre for people with dementia to get involved.

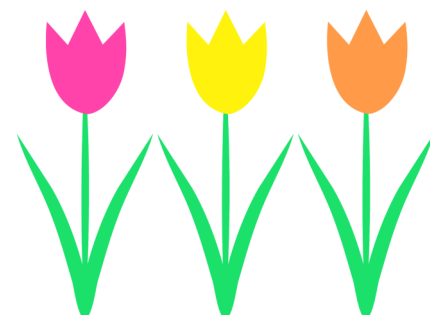
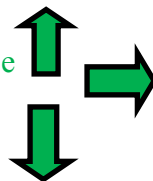

### Welcome to the Spring Newsletter

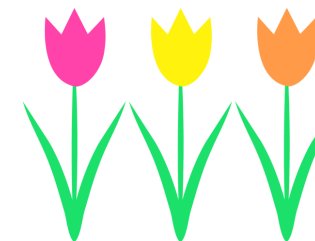
Spring has just about arrived, but we have had some pretty grim weather recently. Thanks to committed volunteers we have continued to provide services even on the most challenging days !

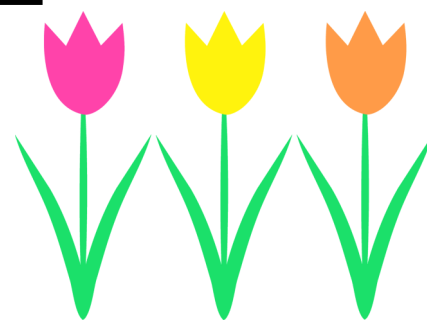
‘Community Care is a wonderful service, it has made a real difference to my life over the last couple of months’

**Hambleton Foodshare is coming to Stokesley...**

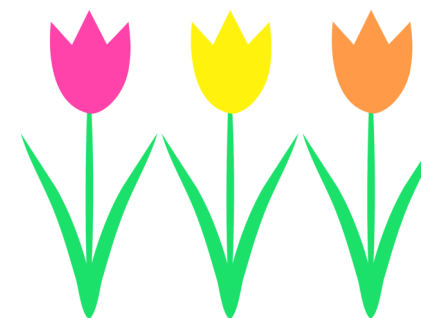
Hambleton Foodshare are based in Northallerton, they run a foodbank to help people who find themselves in temporary crisis.
