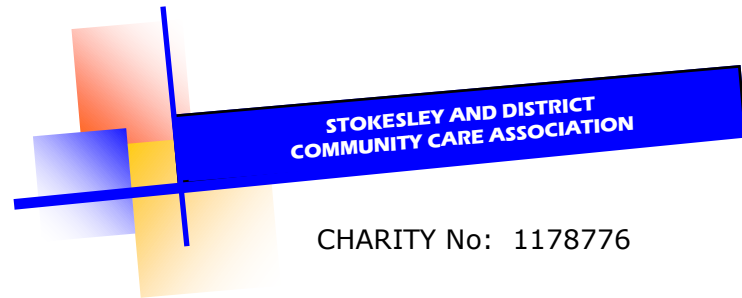

Our befrienders are volunteers and come from all walks of life. They have a wide range of interests and where possible we will aim to match your own interests with theirs to ensure you are well suited. All our befrienders are checked and trained to support you.

Does it cost anything?

There is no charge for the befriending service but we do ask you to cover the cost of mileage for drives and shopping excursions.

How can you register for a befriender?

Call our office on 01642 710085, Monday to Friday between 9am and 5pm. We will arrange for our Community Visiting co-ordinator to visit you and discuss your needs and assign you a well suited befriender.
