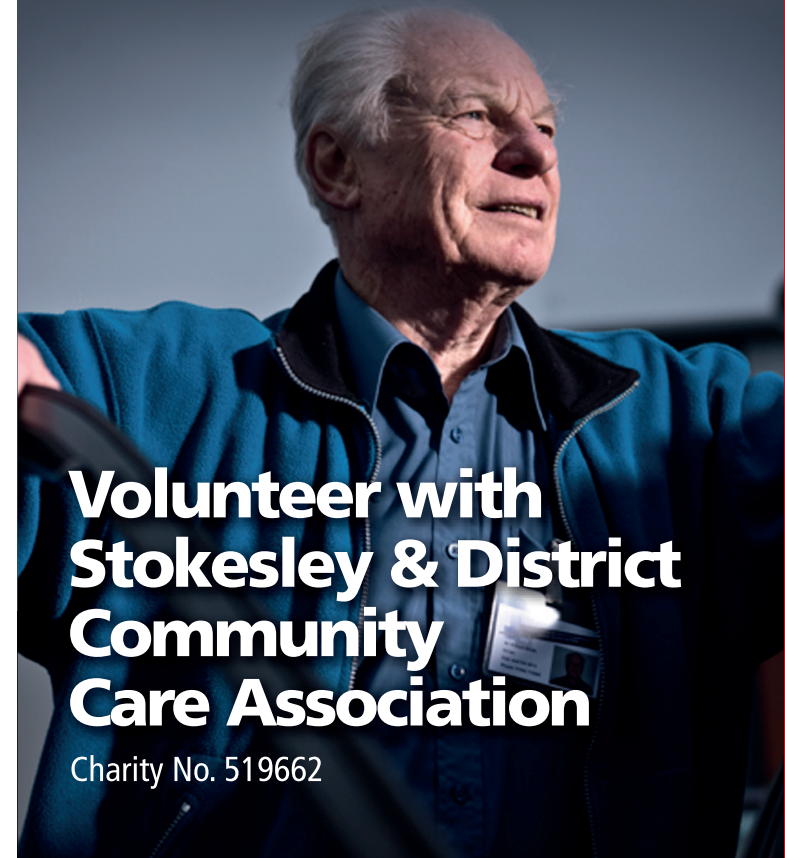

Day Centre

This is our new service to support clients with dementia. We operate Mondays and Wednesdays.

Befriending & Respite Sitting Service

Our volunteers support people who feel socially isolated by visiting them in their own homes.



We also support carers by sitting with the person being cared for.

Lunch Club & Coffee Pop-in

The Lunch club is run each Thursday in Stokesley Town Hall, providing a two course cooked lunch and good company at the same time.



The Coffee pop-in is a fundraiser for us, run each Friday, giving members of the public the chance to catch up for a coffee, cake and chat.

Gentle Exercise Sessions

We run some gentle exercise sessions to help keep people fit and healthy in both body and mind.



Our Chairaerobics is a popular session along with Alive & Active. Volunteers also run PrimeTime which involves indoor bowls and curling. Tea Dances are run alternate Thursdays in Great Ayton.
